

MMSSL Color Key to Sample Ballots From the Judges' Training Video: Event Skills Guide

Words in Black: Black portions on the ballot are the form itself, before it has been used.

Words in Green: These are the portions of the ballot that student speakers have filled out in advance and give to the judges when they first enter the room for a round of competition.

*Words in Blue: These portions are examples of all the ballot areas that the judge has written /filled out while the student was speaking during the round.
Please Note: the bottom ranking and rating portion of the ballot was filled out after ALL students had spoken in the round.*

Blue Highlighted Words: Indicates the connection between the judge's "specific improvement" comment with a particular core skill defined on the ballot.

Purple Highlighted Words: Indicates the connection between the judge's "specific outstanding part" comment with a particular core skill defined on the ballot.
